Appointed by President Clinton in 1997, Wilma Liebman went on to become the third longest-serving member in the 76-year history of the National Labor Relations Board, our nation's 'high court' for adjudicating private-sector disputes between labor and management.

This program will be of interest to anyone who wants to understand the current state of labor in our country. Few Americans are better qualified to lead this discussion than Wilma Liebman.

President Obama designated Wilma B. Liebman to be Chairman of the NLRB on January 20, 2009. She served as Chairman until August 27, 2011, when her third term expired. She is currently a Visiting Professor at the College of Law and the School of Labor and Employment Relations, both at the University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign. She served as Professorial Lecturer in Law at George Washington University Law School, during the spring 2012 semester.

Ms. Liebman holds an A.B. degree from Barnard College and a J.D. from George Washington University Law School. She is a member of the Board of Directors of the Economic Policy Institute and a fellow of The College of Labor and Employment Lawyers, and the American Law Institute.
